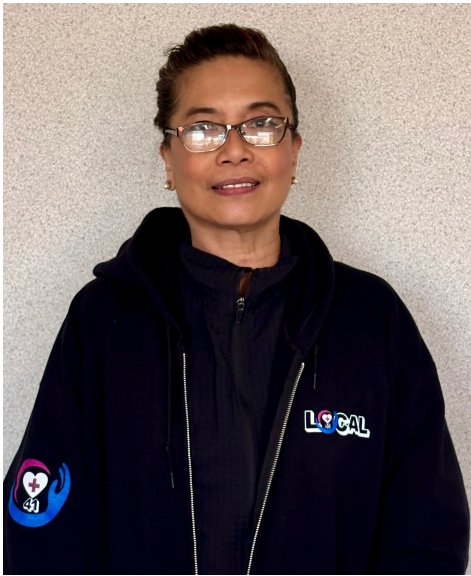
## St. Marguerite Building Steward
