She looks forward to engaging the members of Local 41 to the best of her ability.

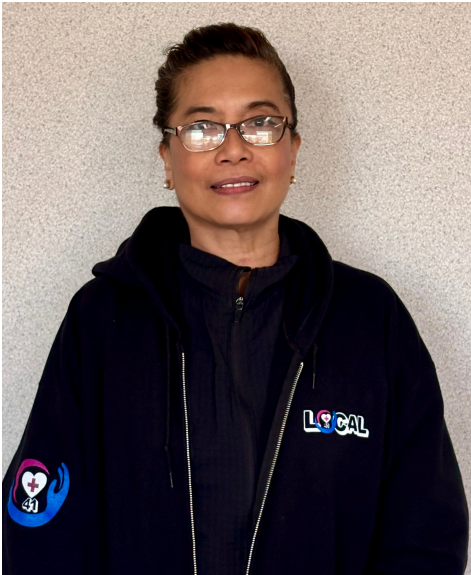
Lakewood Centre Steward OPD
